Counselling

Individual, couple, family and group counselling for clients of all ages

Day Programs

Specialized intensive day treatment programs for women, men and youth

Support Groups

Support groups may be offered including codependency groups, children or teen groups and relapse prevention groups

Home Detox

Specialized program to assist clients to detox safely in their home environment

Methadone Program

Specialized program for individuals wishing to discontinue their use of heroin or other opiates

Prevention & Education

Programs are conducted to educate the community about alcohol and drug abuse. Staff are available to provide presentations to schools, employers and community groups. We are affiliated with the East Kootenay P.A.R.T.Y. Program and Arrive Alive, and are involved with other programs and strategies targeted at children and youth
